Typical Installation

1. The Yellow, White and Red wires are normally open outputs usually connected to the corridor light, the nurse station light and a remote duty station light.
2. The Blue wire is a normally open, momentary contact which is usually connected to the buzzer/sounder.
3. The Grey and Violet wires are normally closed contacts that have current available when the switch is in the "off" (up) position. Cut off or cap if not used in your system.
4. Orange is the incoming power.
5. Green is used for "Ground".
6. The unconnected Black wire from the nurse light is to be connected to the lamp common.
7. Cut off or cap all unused wires.
