

Programming


Enter programming by holding a magnet to the trigger point. When the LED begins flashing, hold the button until the LED stays ON, then release the button and remove the magnet. To enter a digit, press the button that number of times, then touch the magnet – the LED will blink to indicate the digit has been entered. Each program code consists of two digits.
